Creating Multimedia Interactive Posters with Glogster

This Training will be done in a web-based guide. Monique will introduce the training and the main objectives.



Are you tired of assigning your students poster projects that after so much effort in gathering all the supplies and in creating them, they end up crumbled up in the trashcan after class? Have you asked yourself, how can I motivate my students in creating innovative poster projects for presentations, that instead of throwing them away they'll end up talking about them and sharing them with the whole wide world?

Hi my name is Monique and I will show you how to create vibrant multimedia digital posters in a click of a mouse, well something like that! You can create awesome multimedia virtual posters with the use of Glogster.



All you need is a computer, access to the website, have basic computer skills, your Glogster account and finish this training guide. It'll take you only 30 minutes to go through this training and you will be able to create a digital poster on your own.

After completing this instructional training you should be able to log in to Glogster website, create a Glogster by designing it, adding a video and a linking it to another website. You should be able to publish your finished poster and share it with other people.

Follow my directions and you will learn to create fantastic digital posters. If you have any problems I will be here to assist you!




Before proceeding with this training, make sure have already listened to the introductory podcast and responded to the anticipation guide statements.

Step one

Log in to Glogster

Click [here](#) to log in to your Glogster account

You should see this window to log in, type in your nickname and password.



Throughout the training feel free to reference to the Diagram, which is a flow map guide of the steps.



After you have opened Glogster login page, what do you need to do in order to log in?


- A. Type in nickname in the respective box
- B. Type in the password in the respective box
- C. Click on “Log In”
- D. A and B are correct

Step two

Create a Glogster

Once you are logged in click on **CREATE A NEW GLOG** to start

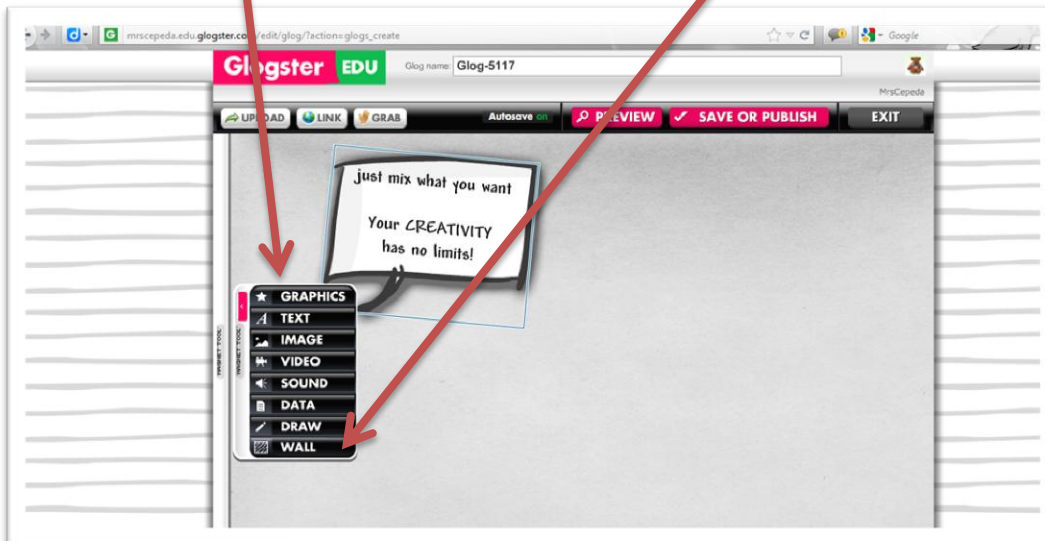
Your first Glogster, which is a digital poster, will be about a College or University. Pick one!

Step three

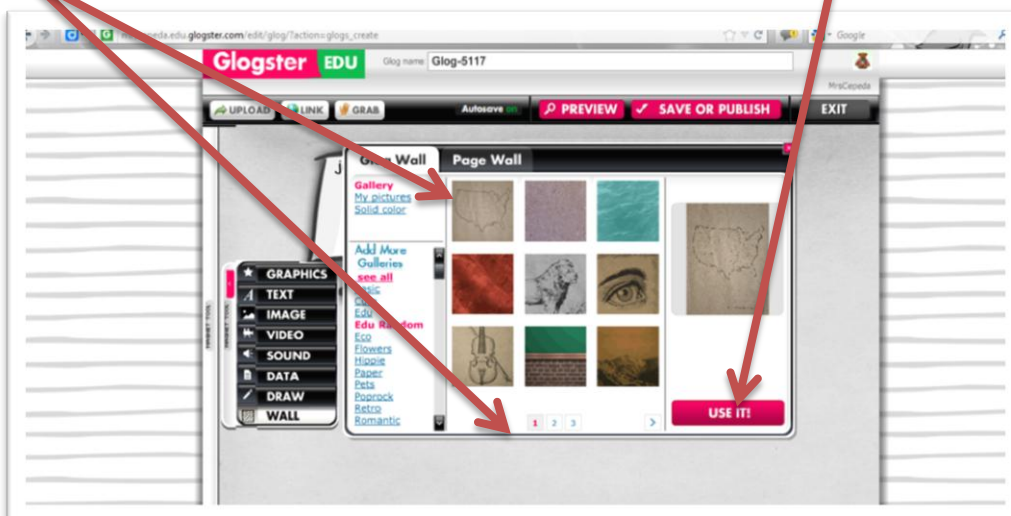
Design your Glogster

Click on the magnet tool box that is located on the left hand side

Click on the **WALL** button



Browse for a desired design and click on the one you want. Click on **USE IT** to post it on your poster





You will repeat the same steps but this time to add GRAPHICS, TEXT and IMAGES

___a) On the magnet tool click on “graphics”

___b) select desired graphic by clicking on it

___c) Click on “use it!” box

___d) Close magnet tool box and position graphic to design poster

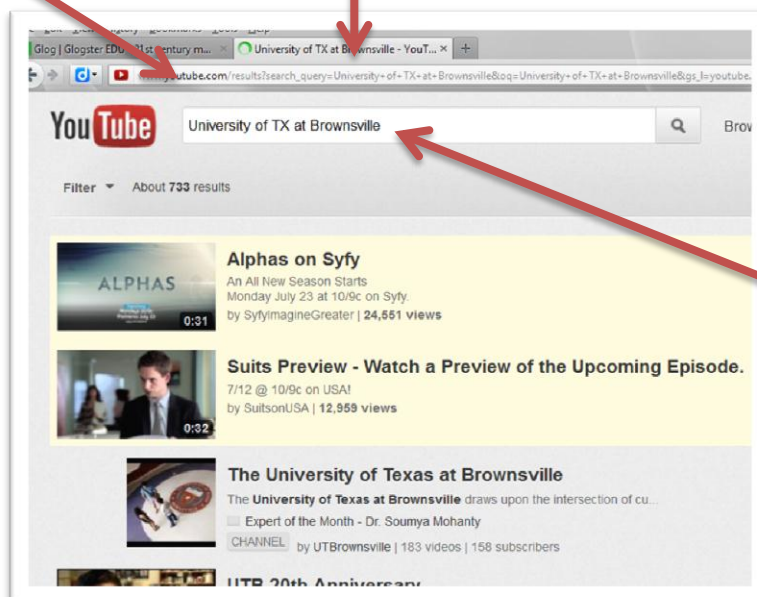

Step four

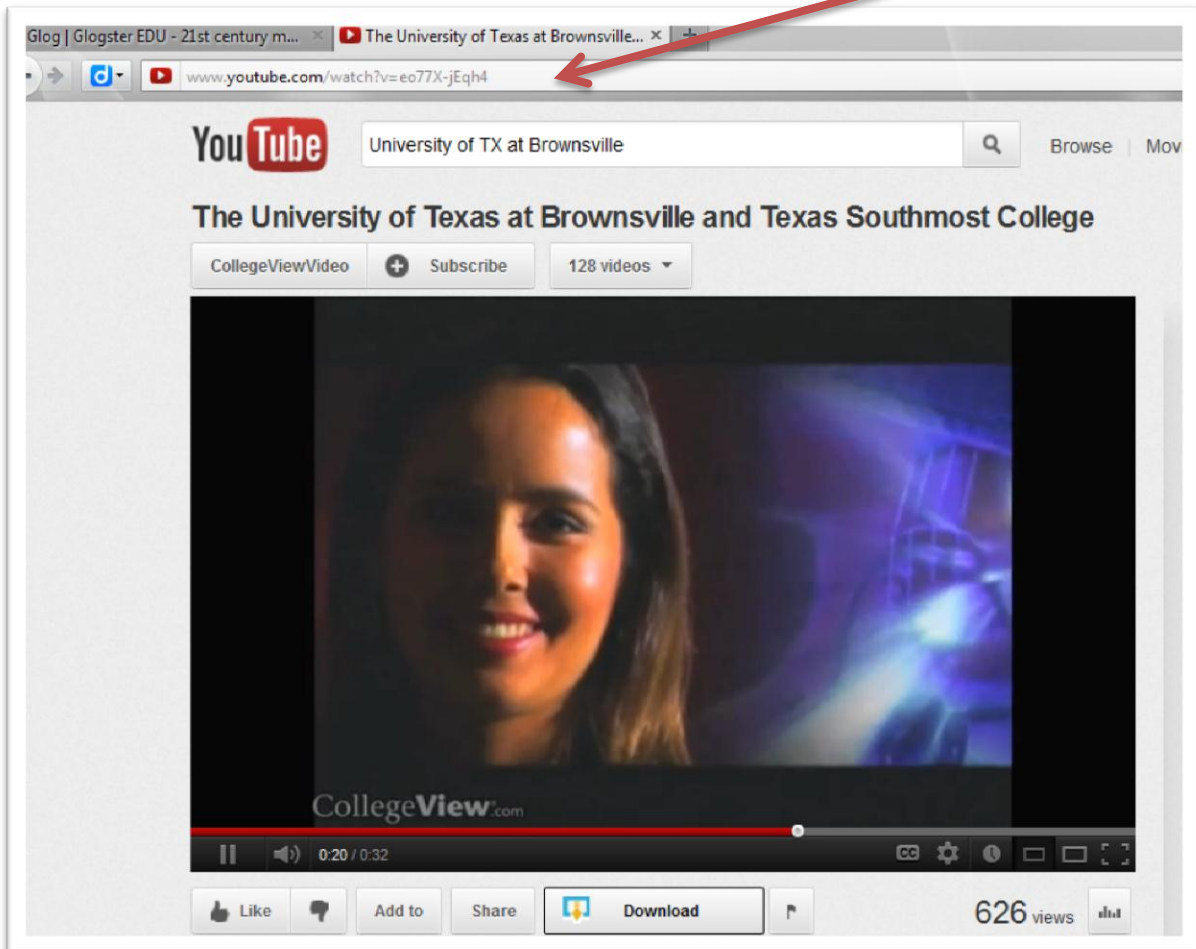
Add a Video

Click [HERE](#) to open YouTube page. Or open another web browser window and type in www.youtube.com



Find a video about the desired college or university by typing its name

Once you find the desired video click on it. Then once it starts playing it copy the link from the top by **right clicking** your mouse on it and selecting **copy**



Go back to Glogster page and click on the magnetic tool box on **VIDEO**

Click on the **LINK** box



Paste video link inside **LINK** box and click on **ADD TO YOUR FILES**



Click on **USE IT!** To display the video on your Glogster



Where do you click on the magnet tool in order to insert a YouTube video?

- a) Click on “Video”, then on “Upload” button
- b) Click on “Video”, then on “Link” button
- c) Click on “Video”, then on “Grab” button

Answer: B

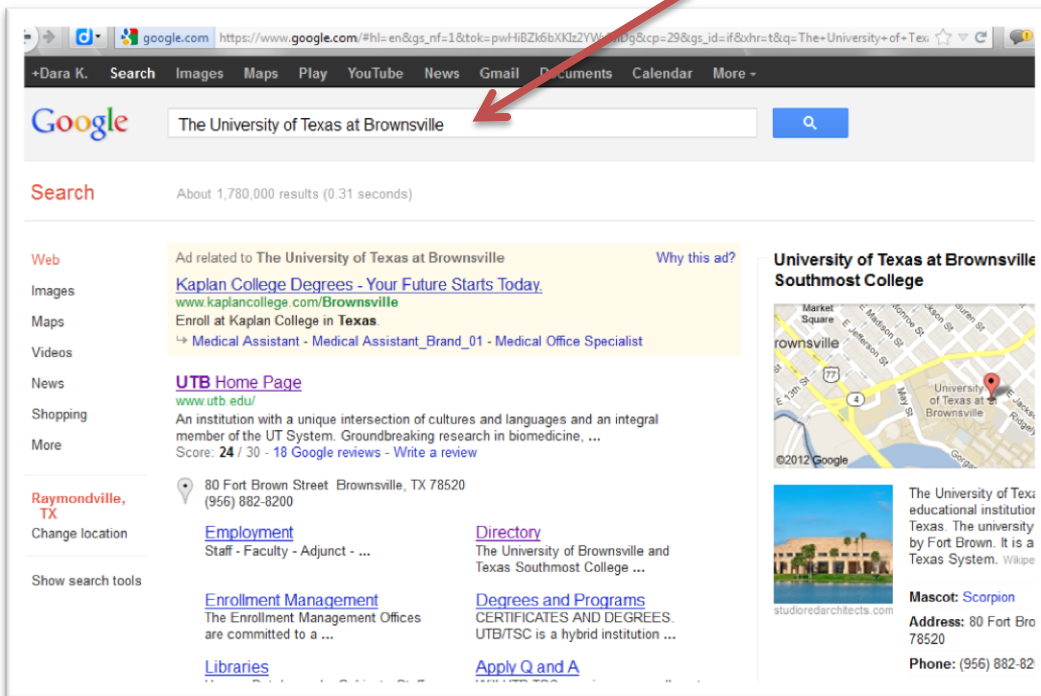


Step five

Add a Link

Click [HERE](#) to access Google search engine. Or open another web browser and type in www.google.com

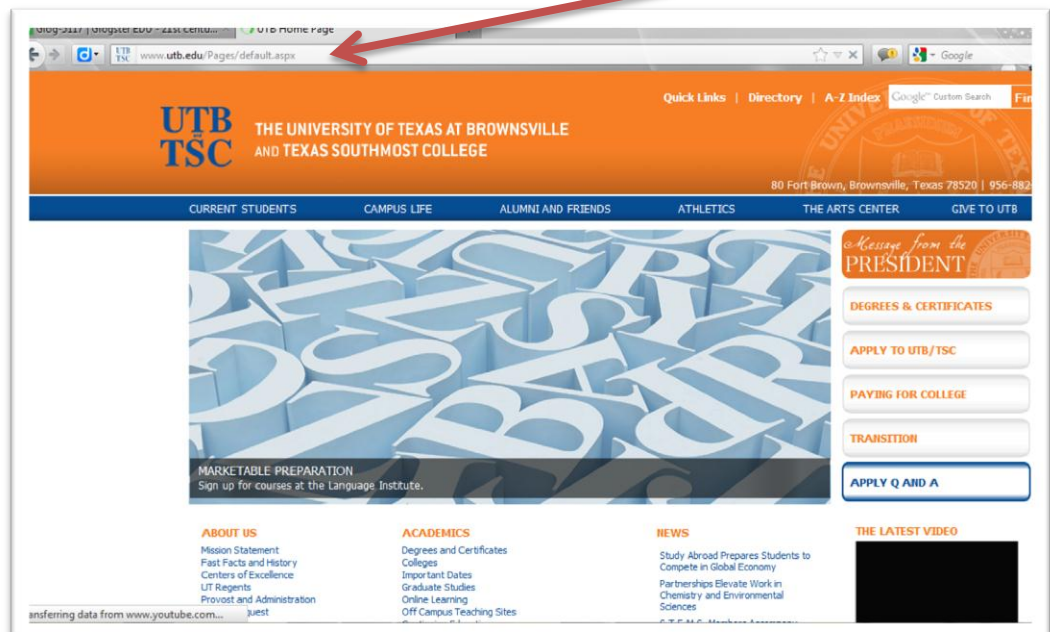
Search for the University or College website by typing the name. Once you find the official website click enter.



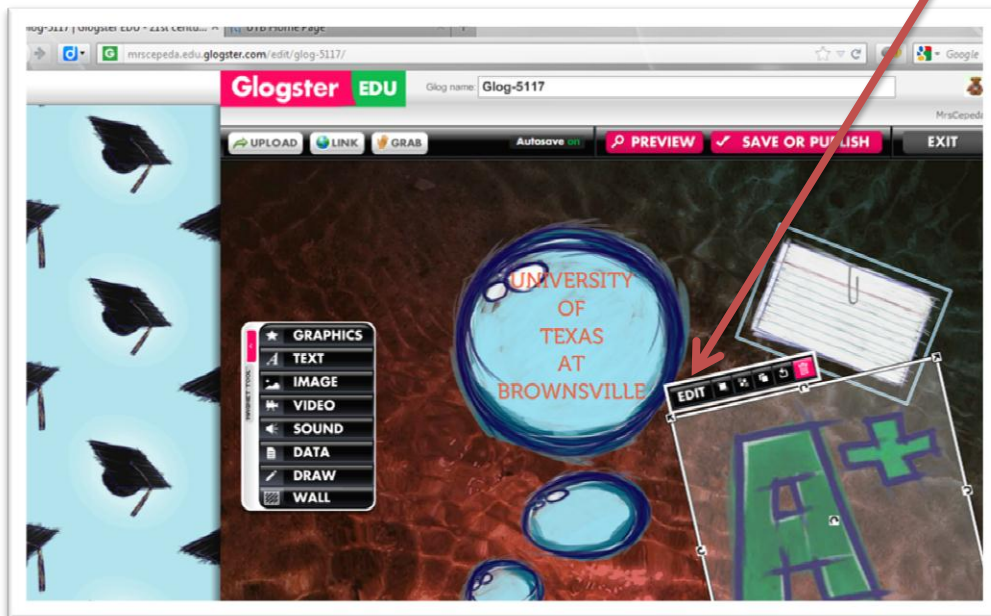
As you can see I picked

Once the webpage is opened, go to the top of the page. Again by using your mouse right click and **copy** the website link and go back to Glogster page.



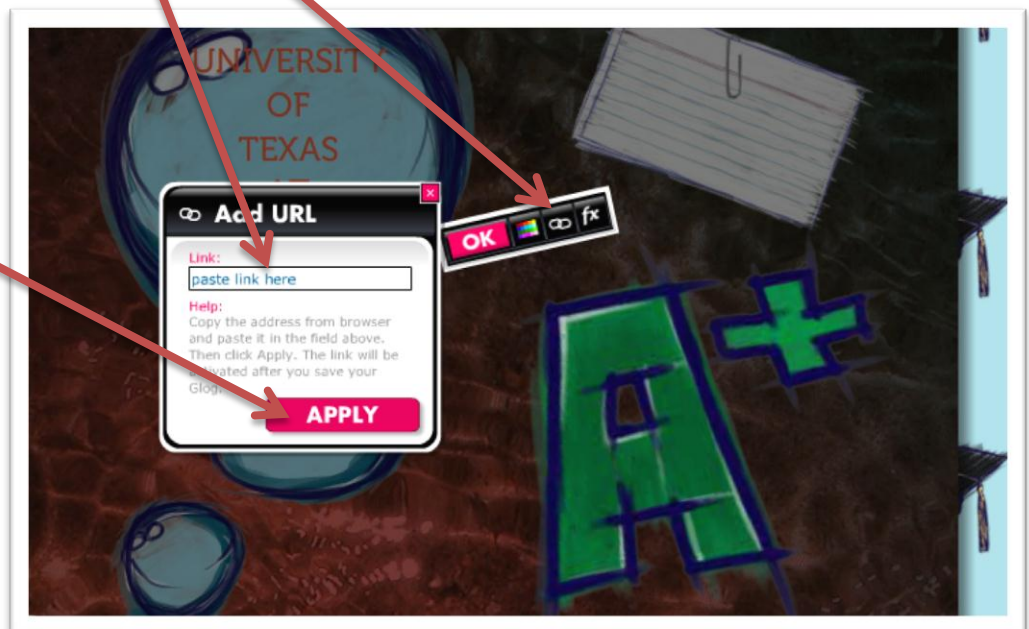
Click on any GRAPHIC placed in Click on any **GRAPHIC** placed in your Glogster and click **EDIT**



Click on the third button and paste website link.

By right clicking your mouse and selecting PASTE

Then click **APPLY**.





All of these are steps in inserting a link to another website on the interactive poster, *except*?

- a) Place your mouse on any graphic or text already displayed on the poster and click “Edit”
- b) Click on the button that has a chain graphic and says “Add link”
- c) Right click mouse and paste link inside “link” box
- d) Type “Add link” inside box
- e) Click “Apply”

Answer: D

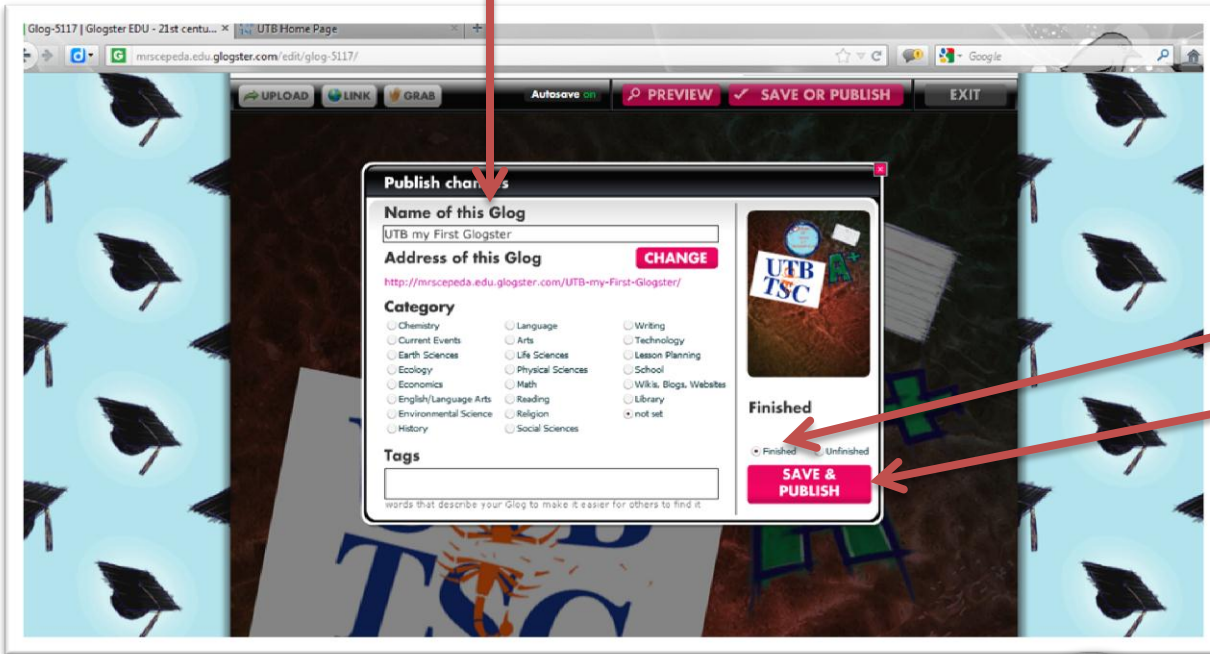
Step six

Save and Publish your Glogster

Once you are finished designing your Glogster and adding the media tools, then click on **SAVE OR PUBLISH** link, located on the right top of Glogster

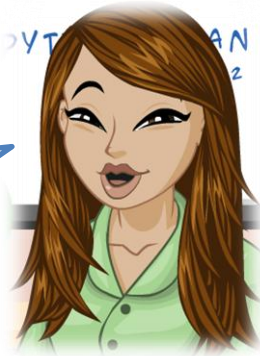


Name your Glogster by typing its name inside box



Click on **Finished**
and then **SAVE & PUBLISH**

Number steps to save and publish a Glogster in order starting from 1 to 4.

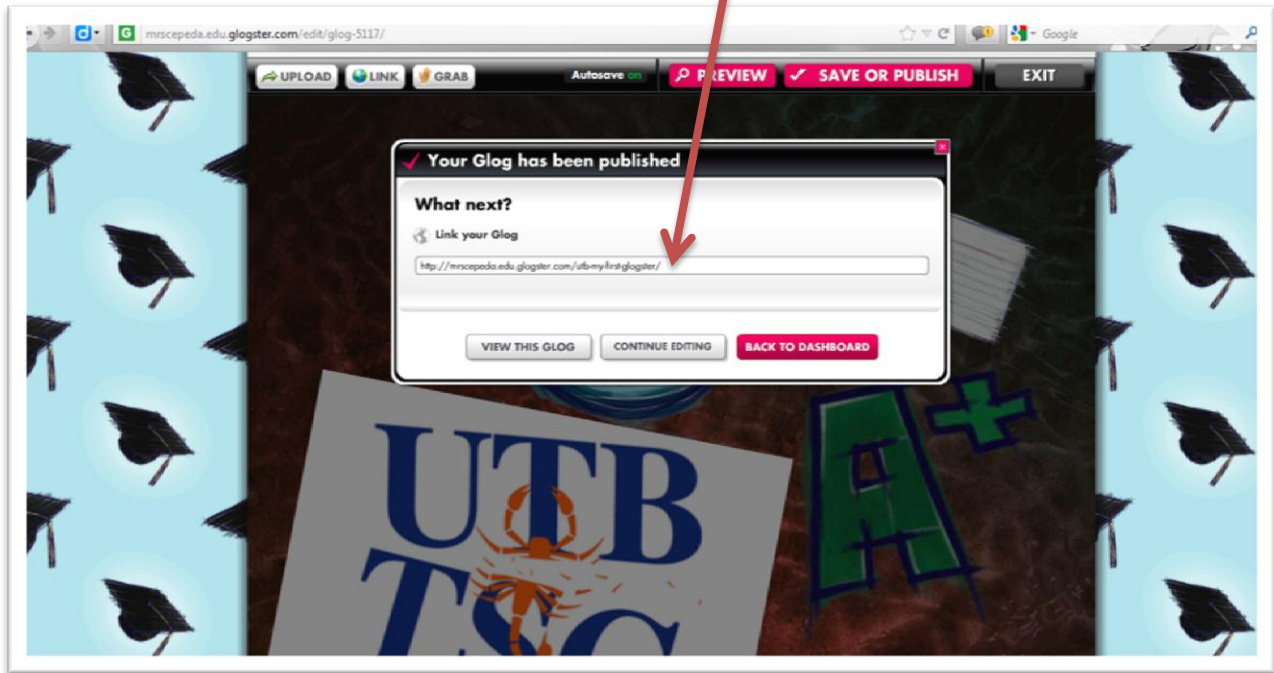
- ___ Click on “Save or Publish”
- ___ Select “Finished”
- ___ Type in name of Glog in the respective box
- ___ Click on “Save”

Answer: 1, 3, 2, 4

Step seven

Share your Glogster

Copy Glogster link by using your mouse and share it by emailing it to other people.



True or False. After saving and publishing your Glogster, a notice box will pop up saying “Your Glog has been published. What is next?” You can find the link to your Glogster in the same box and copy it to share it with others.

Answer: True

After you have obtained your Glogster link and shared it, you can view your Finished Glogster and check if all media tools function properly and you may continue editing anytime you prefer! Don't worry your Glogster link stay the same.



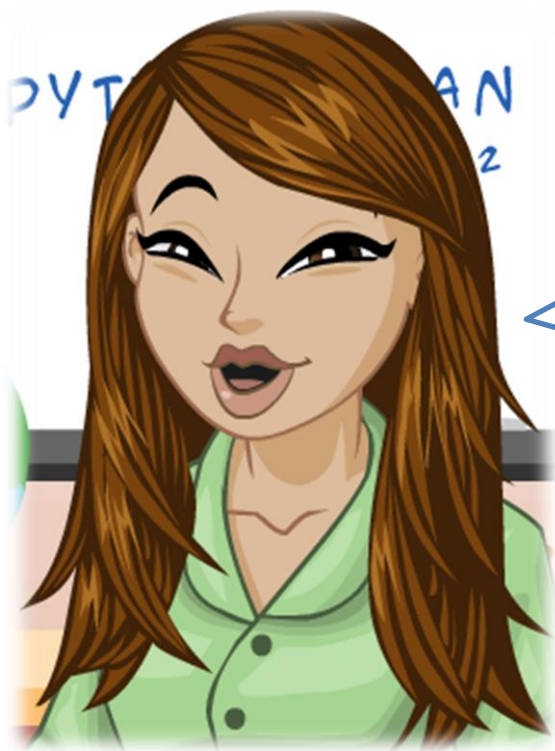


Before you get your Certificate of Completion you must evaluate your finished Glogster with the Post Test Checklist to see if you were able to achieve the objectives.
